NOTE: There is a \$17 fee for switching activities during the day.

Scholarships:

Scholarships are available for students that are *absolutely unable* to pay program fees. The school uses their own judgment in determining *legitimate financial hardship*. Please indicate Scholarship kids in the “paid” column of the registration form. Scholarship rates are as follows:

- Free for students skiing
- \$27 for students snowboarding and renting a Showdown Montana snowboard
- Free for students on their own snowboard

Notes on Program Fees:

- Due to the already low cost of the program, we cannot further reduce the cost for students who do not need rental equipment or who have their own season pass.
- Chaperone rates are available to **one adult for every five students**. Home schools are limited to one Teacher. Exceptions may be granted for escorts of Special Needs Students.
- Community Rates are available for other adults and family members who will be traveling with the school, but who are not Teachers or Chaperones. These individuals are not included in the school paperwork; they just declare themselves a “community member” at Guest Services and Snow School Sales, ticket office, or rental shop and proceed through with the appropriate paperwork and payment.

Students with Special Needs

Our partnership with Eagle Mount ensures that students with developmental or physical disabilities can enjoy skiing and snowboarding right alongside their friends. Any student who requires specialized assistance or one-on-one attention is eligible. Eagle Mount’s services are not an additional cost. There is not always an Eagle Mount representative on site at Showdown, so **please contact Eagle Mount directly at 406.454.1449** at least one month prior to your visit to arrange for their services. Parents *must* sign an Eagle Mount liability release in addition to the Showdown Montana release.

Teacher/Chaperone Responsibilities

One teacher is the coordinator and does all correspondence with Guest Services. The other teachers assist the coordinator as needed. Chaperone rates are available to one adult for every five participating students. This individual is not paid by the school, such as the teacher, bus driver, or principal. We offer these rates to encourage schools to bring an appropriate number of adults above and beyond teachers for supervising their students. Chaperones are responsible for aiding students in getting dressed, retrieving and keeping track of their rental equipment, ensuring that students make it to lessons on time, and supervising students when they are not in a lesson. Equipment and lift tickets will be provided to Chaperones only after all students have made their way through the rental shop and out to the lesson area. Chaperones are welcome to participate in lessons at no charge, so long as they are not disruptive and/or occupying a disproportionate amount of the instructor’s time. Our first priority must be the students. Adults not willing to perform the duties listed above can pay Community Rates instead, and just go play for the day.

Payment Options

Teacher coordinator pays for their PE day in a single transaction at Guest Services with a school Check, school Purchase Order, Cash, Visa, Mastercard or Discover. **Plan to collect cash or personal checks made payable to your school from students well in advance of the scheduled trip day.**
